Fresno photographer Paul Kalinian is in the process of producing a 30 minute non-profit documentary film highlighting the life of William Saroyan-author, playwright, and humanitarian.

In the first part of the film, William Saroyan talks about his childhood memories, his parents, and his early life. His spoken recollections are coupled with old-time Fresno scenes, depicting the times, the moods, and the places of his life. The film will also show unique and characteristic color portraits of William Saroyan along with a fascinating story about an unusual photographic session. The final part of the film is a summarization of Saroyan's sixty-year writing career.

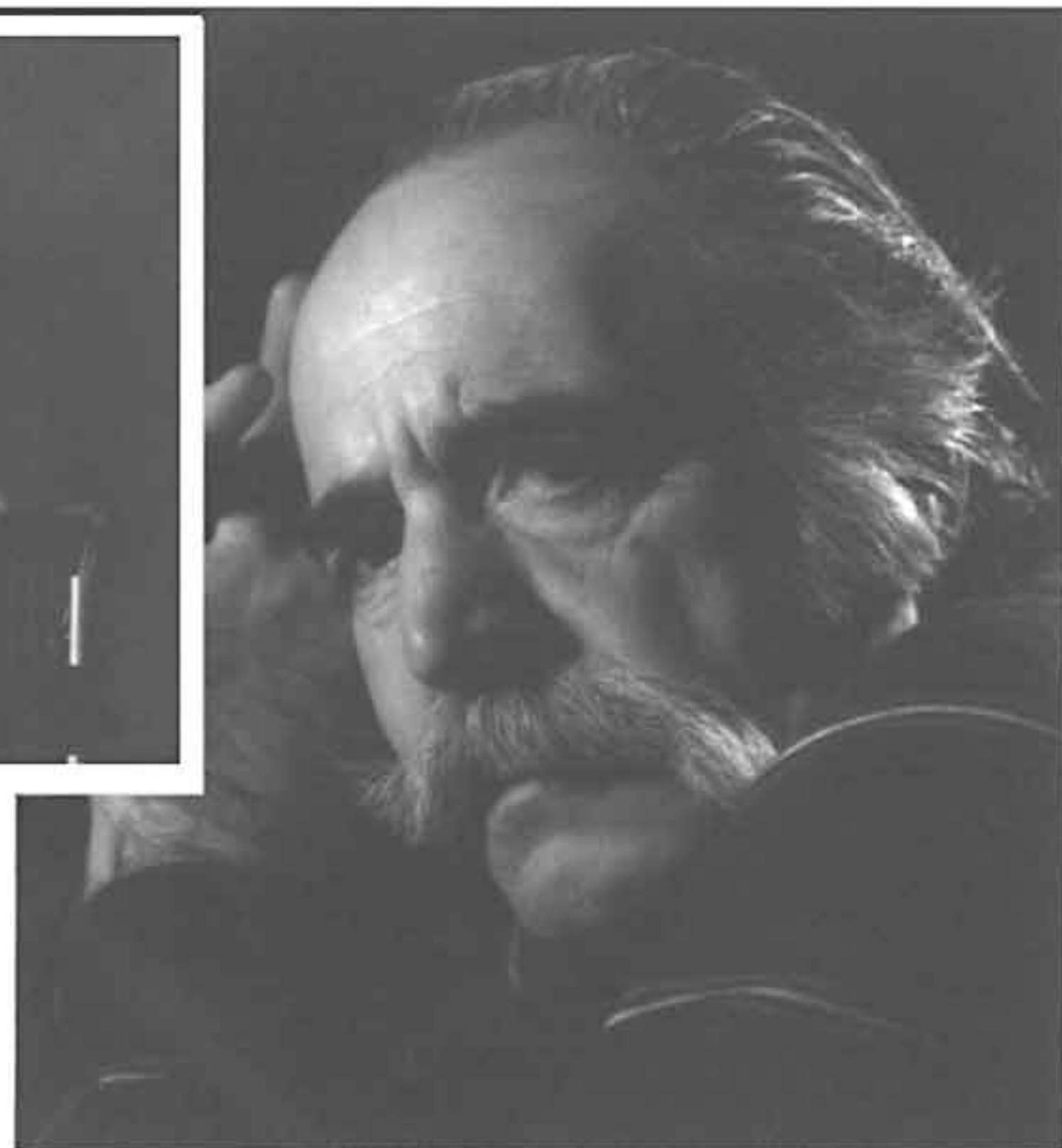
To immortalize William Saroyan's memories on film, we will need about \$30,000. With your generous support, this worthy project will soon be completed.
